Facts

She advertises her Web site address in the print and electronic versions of various national financial magazines and newspapers. Interested readers across the country may access the site free-of-charge over the Internet. **Question 1** ⓘ Our present information is that approximately 50 investment clubs and individual readers from around the nation "hit" the site a collective total of roughly 200 times per month, but stock market professionals and commercial investors almost never look at it.

The site is set up in a "read-only" format. It is not interactive, in that Ms. Anderson does not identify an address or phone number for inquiries, does not initiate or reply to e-mails, does not send out brochures or other print material, does not make phone calls to or receive phone calls from readers, etc. **Question 2** ⓘ Her site expressly disclaims any purpose to offer financial advice.

Question 3 ⓘ Some time in February 2003, a reader of the site, who happens to be a friend of our client, advised him that there was information on it about him. When our client accessed the site, he found the following paragraph:

our client, Fred Doe ("Doe"), assert personal jurisdiction in his home state of North Pacific over Amber Anderson ("Anderson") for a defamatory statement published on Anderson's Web site that has been constructed at the computer in her home located in western Pennsylvania?





You may wish to embed question link icons into text. Place icons next to the **Question #** you typed. This will allow user to click "?" icon to call up the relevant question.

Steps to add Question Link: After you create your question, click the hyperlink  symbol next to the question, position your cursor where you want to insert ? mark icon, then select the **Insert Question Link** tab and **Submit**.

To delete the question link, click on hyperlink icon and simply use delete button on keyboard and click Submit to save change.

Note: It is possible to insert more than one question link per individual question.
