

TWEN® Document Quizzing

Document Quizzing allows you to group questions relevant to specific text and allows students to answer questions based on the context of same. Examples include briefs, transcripts, and fact patterns.

Step 1
Create Quiz *

Step 2
Create Section*

Step 3
Type text into **Section Text** or paste from word processor (formatting will be lost)

Best Practice
Type the **Question #** into your text to coincide with context for your questions. Use color/ bold type.

Step 4
Create/import all questions relevant to the text you added in your quiz section

Step 5-Optional
Embed question link icons into text. By inserting Question Link Icons in your text, students will be able to call up the relevant question by clicking on the orange "?" icon. Steps below or click here for a short video tutorial 

Note: Students may also use the left-hand question navigation to pull questions if you don't wish to add these links.

Grid View

You may wish to embed question link icons into text. Place icons next to the **Question #** you typed. This will allow user to click "?" icon to call up the relevant question.

Steps to add Question Link: After you create your question, click the hyperlink  symbol next to the question, position your cursor where you want to insert ? mark icon, then select the **Insert Question Link** tab and **Submit**.

To delete the question link, click on hyperlink icon and simply use delete button on keyboard and click Submit to save change.

Note: It is possible to insert more than one question link per individual question.
