

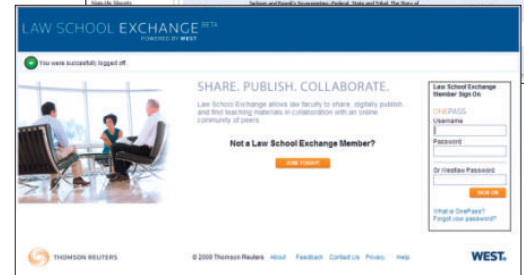


# Law School Exchange

## Share: An online community that connects law school faculty and content

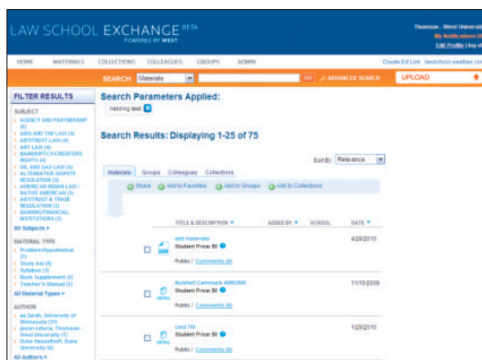
Use Law School Exchange to share materials with your colleagues, create resources, exchange scholarship material, build on each other's work, and leverage best teaching practices.

You can post resources to your Law School Exchange collection, such as:

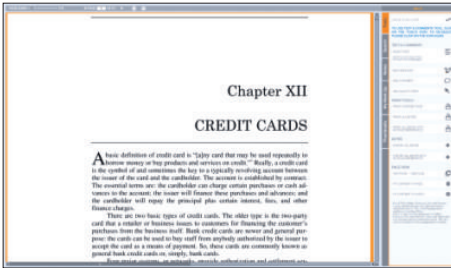
- Articles

The Law School Exchange Document Viewer presents material in a Web-friendly format.

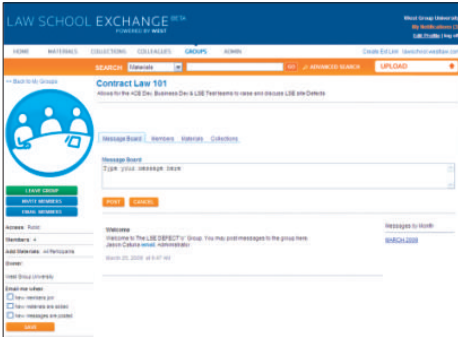
**Publish: A channel for developing and publishing your work in new forms**
